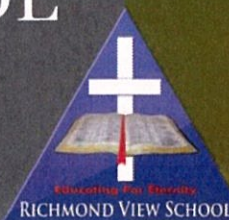

### 2018 ENROLMENT FORM

Welcome to another wonderful year of music! The RVS Music Academy exists to help make it possible for each child to discover their musical ability and to this end we continue to offer parents significantly discounted charges for music lessons. In order to also respect and value our music tutors, it is important you know and understand our **Fee Policies**:

1. Any family with outstanding fees for 2017 music lessons will not have their 2018 enrolments processed until accounts are paid in full.
2. The 2018 lesson fees are set at term rates clearly stated in the attached Information sheet. Invoices will be emailed out at the beginning of each term and payment is due by the end of week 4 each term.
3. From Term 2 onwards, 2018 accounts not being paid on time will incur postponement or even cancellation of the child's lessons.
4. Music students are expected to attend every music lesson - we are not able to arrange makeup lessons due to the school's timetable.
5. Credits will only be given when: a) tutors are unavailable; b) children are on a school scheduled outing on their music day; or c) parents have advised the music tutor in writing (by text or email) before 10am on their music day.

## 2018 RVS MUSIC ACADEMY ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

### **Choir – Thursday lunchtimes (1 - 1.30pm) beginning week 4 of Term 1**

The school Choir is open to all RVS students from Year 4 upwards who would like to be involved in a fun and busy singing program. In Term 1 we will be working on a series of vocal warm-ups that teach singing technique and knit us together as one voice. In Terms 2 & 3 we expect to be rehearsing for and taking part in the World Vision Kids for Kids concert. In Term 4 we will be learning some songs to perform with the school orchestra, hopefully in an outreach situation. So lots to look forward to!

*Thursday lunchtimes (30 minutes); No fees involved; Required: a clear file folder for song sheets.*

### **Clarinet and Saxophone Lessons – Charlotte Panoho**

Once again our gracious Charlotte is looking forward to teaching Saxophone and Clarinet this year. Instruments can be hired for a full school year from either Ken Ham's Music Works store or the Music Works website [www.musicworks.co.nz](http://www.musicworks.co.nz) (Saxophone \$300-\$390 and Clarinet \$130-270 – cost depends on brand hired) or from KBB Music at [www.kbbmusic.co.nz](http://www.kbbmusic.co.nz) (Saxophone \$265; Clarinet \$150). Hire plans from both places include instrument service & maintenance and have optional insurance protection. If you would prefer to purchase, Trademe can be a good source and Charlotte will be happy to work with you to find the right instrument for your child.

*Group lesson (20 or 30 minutes): \$60/school term; Private lesson (20 minutes): \$120/school term. All Charlotte's students will require a clear-file folder for their music sheets.*

### **Drum Lessons – Annie Harper**

We are thrilled to announce that the upbeat Annie Harper is joining our team of tutors this year. Annie is a parent of 3 (soon to be 4) children at RVS and is an excellent drummer who plays regularly at Nativity Church. She will be offering drum lessons to Room 5 & 6 students only. Her students will work their way through the Progressive Beginner Drum course book first, then concentrate on developing consistency and style whilst drumming to music. All students will benefit greatly from having their own drum set at home (or at the very least some understanding parents with pots and pans available!)

*Group lesson (30 minutes): \$60/school term; No private lessons, sorry. Course book estimated at \$35-\$65 each (supplier dependant).*

### **Flute and Recorder Lessons – Peata Panoho**

Once again our lovely Peata is looking forward to teaching Recorder and Flute this year. Please purchase recorders from a music store only. Flutes can be hired for a full school year from either Ken Ham's Music Works store or the Music Works website [www.musicworks.co.nz](http://www.musicworks.co.nz) (\$150-210 – cost depends on brand hired) or from KBB Music at [www.kbbmusic.co.nz](http://www.kbbmusic.co.nz) (\$150 – 210). Hire plans from both places include instrument service & maintenance and have optional insurance protection. If you would prefer to purchase a flute, Trademe can be a good source and Peata will be happy to work with you to find the right instrument for your child.

*No Group lessons, sorry; Private lesson (20 minutes): \$120/school term. All Peata's students will require a scrapbook to stick their music sheets in, and Flute students will need a music stand at home to help them maintain correct posture whilst practising. Music stands can be purchased from Ken Ham's music store, priced from \$30.*

## **Guitar and Ukulele Lessons – Stephanie Ham**

Once again the vibrant Stephanie is back with Guitar and Ukulele lessons. Instruments can be hired either from the school or from Stephanie herself for just (\$15/term). If you are considering purchasing a guitar, please see Stephanie first so she can help you get the right size for your child. All students will benefit greatly from having a music stand and a guitar tuner at home to practice with. A pick holder and a couple of .58 gauge (red) picks are essential, as is a large clear-file folder for their music (eg. new students should purchase a 60-page clear-file). A Guitar/Ukulele course book will also be used throughout the year.

*Group lesson (20-30 minutes): \$60/school term; Private lesson (20 minutes): \$120/school term - availability of private lessons dependant on tutor's schedule. Course book estimated at \$30-\$60 each (supplier dependant). Ken Ham's music store has picks at approx. \$1 each & pick holders approx. \$5 each.*

## **Keyboard Lessons – Charlotte, Peata, and Stephanie**

Unfortunately we have not yet sourced a new keyboard tutor, so cannot offer lessons to students who are new to this instrument. We are however going to do our best to keep lessons going for those students who were learning keyboard last year and wish to continue. Please join us in praying for a new tutor to join our team and take on the vital role of tutoring beginners in keyboard.

*Group lesson (20 or 30 minutes): \$60/school term; Private lesson (20 minutes): \$120/school term  
Course books estimated at \$15 - \$35 each (supplier dependant).  
Some students may require a clear file folder for sheet music.*

## **Orchestra – Wednesday lunchtimes (1 – 1.30pm) beginning week 6 of Term 1**

The school Orchestra is an integral part of the development of our music students. It helps them develop an ear for good music and being in tune, patience as a member of a team, and rhythm as they all learn to play in time with each other following the conductor. Students who take part in the orchestra come away at the end of the year with a real sense of pride in how they have developed musically and what they have achieved together for performances. This year we will be working on a repertoire of both orchestral music and songs with the choir to be performed in Term 4, hopefully in an outreach situation.

The school Orchestra is open to all RVS Music Academy students who have been learning their instruments for a year or more and have developed beyond beginner level. We welcome all interested students to register their desire to be involved.

## **Vocal Lessons – Alison Dight**

We are thrilled to announce that the bubbly Alison Dight is joining our team of tutors this year. With Alison on board, the RVS Music Academy can for the first time offer vocal lessons. Alison's students will learn music theory alongside singing techniques and developing a repertoire. Alison will be offering both private and group sessions. Group sessions will be suitable for most students. Private sessions will be best for those students performing in competitions or shows so they can benefit from one-on-one specialised attention. All students will be provided with their own book from the Full Voice series to work through, along with a "kit" containing clear file, pencil, homework book, and reference sheets.

*Group lesson (30 minutes): \$60/school term; Private lesson (20 minutes): \$120/school term  
Course book and kit: \$35 for the year.*
